The purpose of the project is to improve safety, increase capacity, and reduce delays along US 501 and US 221, which currently present some of the highest levels of congestion in the City of Lynchburg.

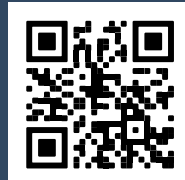
Public Involvement
